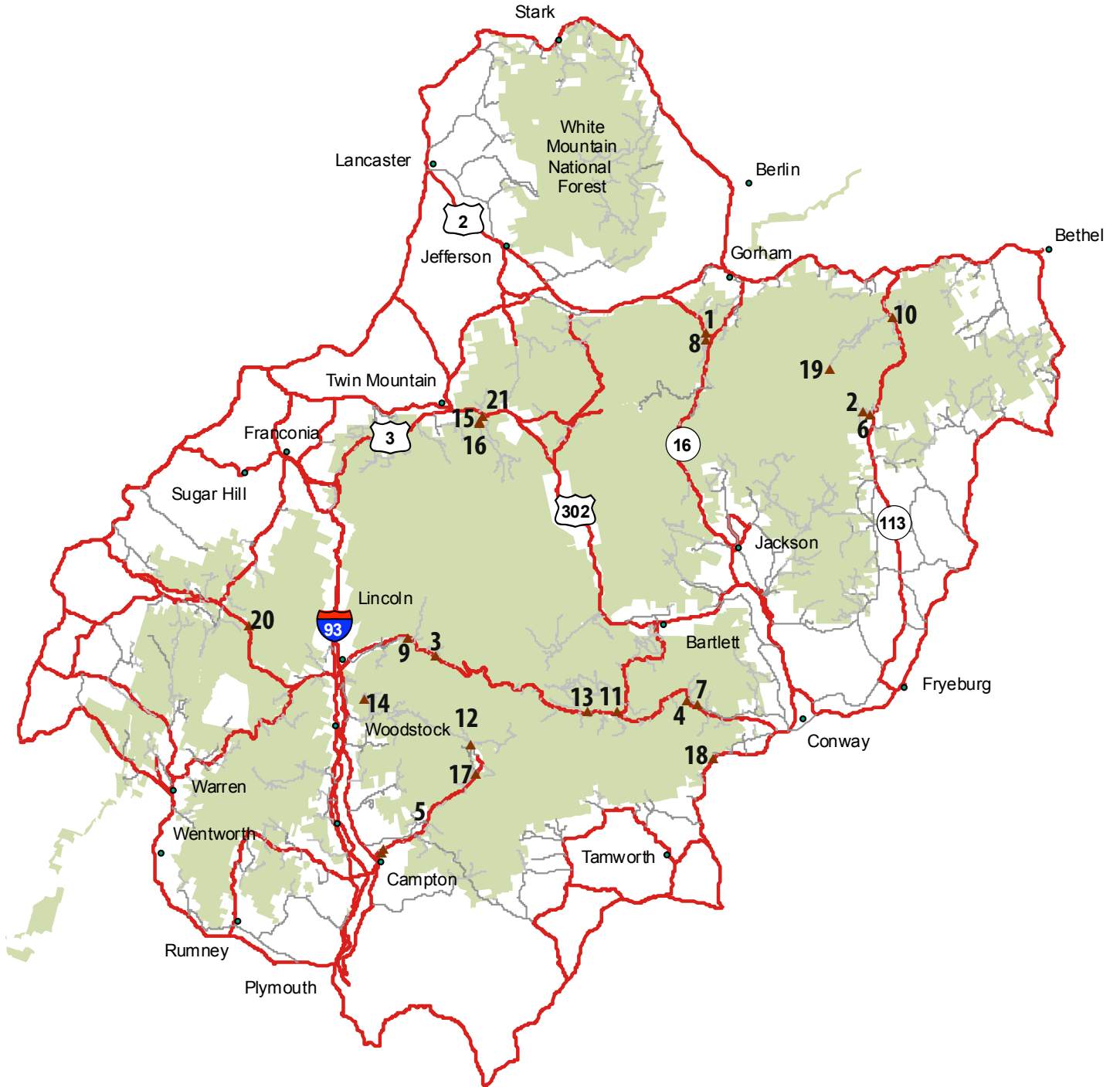

onto the White Mountain National Forest that originated outside New Hampshire or Maine. Several invasive insects that can be transported in firewood pose a threat to our forests.



## CAMPGROUND FEES AND RESERVATIONS

Campground fees range from \$16 to \$22 per night, and include one motor vehicle. A fee of \$5 is charged for each additional vehicle, and there is a maximum of two vehicles allowed per site. A maximum of eight people are allowed per site.

Designated sites can be reserved at some White Mountain National Forest Campgrounds; others are first-come, first-served. Reservations may be made

by phone (877-444-6777 / TTY: 877-833-6777) or internet ([www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov)), and must be made at least 7 days before date of arrival.

Holders of an Interagency Senior, Interagency Access, Golden Age, or Golden Access pass receive a 50% discount on camping fees. The pass holder must be one of the campers.
